Acupuncture in NIH: A Trend Analysis of Projects and Fundings

The number and amount of projects that have "acupuncture" (including "electroacupuncture", "acupressure", and "Auricular acupressure") in the title, however, fluctuated over the years. In 2020, there were 10 projects with a total funding of \$7.68 million; in 2021, there were 16 projects with a total funding of \$11.03 million; in 2022, there were 14 projects with a total funding of \$7.48 million; and in 2023, there were 14 projects with a total funding of \$6.31 million. However, the funding for acupuncture research from the National Institutes of Health (NIH) is very low, ranging from 0.01% to 0.02% of the total NIH budget. This poses a challenge for advancing the evidence base and the clinical application of acupuncture. The possible interpretation is that acupuncture research is facing some challenges in NIH, such as difficulty of preparing and submitting high-quality grant applications, limited funding sources, lack of standardized protocols, ethical issues, and scientific rigor.

CCMU Continued to Offer Free and Low-Cost Treatments to the Community in 2023, with the Support of CMCO

In 2022, CCMU offered a total of 2,914 free or discounted treatments valued at \$79,993. Building upon this initiative, in 2023, we expanded our efforts, providing 3,917 treatments at no cost or reduced prices, with a total value of \$96,679. This marked a significant increase of 13% in the number of treatments offered and a 21% rise in their total value compared to the previous year.
