CCMU DAOM Clinic: A Strong Start with Positive Outcomes

From March 4th to March 8th, the DAOM cohort at Colorado Chinese Medicine University successfully completed its first clinic session, demonstrating the power and effectiveness of acupuncture treatments. Throughout the week, patients experienced significant improvements, with many reporting reduced pain, enhanced relaxation, and increased energy.

Key highlights from the clinic included:

- **Pain Relief:** Multiple patients experienced a noticeable decrease in pain, including relief from headaches, shoulder pain, throat discomfort, and overall body aches.
- **Balanced Pulses:** 90 percent cases showed pulses shifting toward balance, indicating improved internal harmony, though some still required continued treatment.
- **Increased Energy and Emotional Well-being:** Patients frequently reported feeling more energized, warmer, and emotionally lighter, with some experiencing improved mood and the release of negative emotions.

- **Immediate Effects:** In several instances, patients noticed changes right after the first 1 or 2 needle insertions, including clearer vision, deeper breathing, and a warming sensation flowing through the body.
- **Deeper Learning for Practitioners:** The session emphasized the importance of accurate diagnosis and pulse assessment, reinforcing key skills for our DAOM students in refining their clinical expertise.

While the majority of treatments were highly effective, some cases did not achieve the expected results due to incorrect diagnoses. This highlights the need for continued practice in pulse diagnosis and a deeper understanding of individualized treatment approaches.

This successful first clinic session reflects the dedication of our DAOM students and faculty, setting a strong foundation for the rest of the program. We look forward to seeing even greater progress in future sessions!
